Position Summary:

Volunteer will create and maintain a safe and fun environment for children to play while mothers attend our support groups.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide supervision for a group of 4-10 children at all times
- Facilitate fun and engaging activities while maintaining safety
- Be respectful, friendly, and courteous to all children and parents
- Keep play areas clean and organized during and after shift
- Other duties as assigned and needed

Time Commitment:

Commit to one 2-hour shift per week. Current open shifts:

- Tuesdays 4-6pm (Spanish-speaking support group; bilingual volunteer desired)
- Tuesdays 6-8pm
- Thursdays 6-8 pm

Requirements:

- Complete a volunteer application and interview
- Must be CPR-trained
- Must pass a background check
- Training to be completed once accepted
