Food Lifeline Volunteer

Position Summary:

Safeway and DAWN are partnering to reduce food waste while providing for the daily needs of domestic violence survivors at our confidential shelter. Volunteers are needed to build relationships with our partners at Safeway while collecting donated food items, and deliver to the shelter to sort and distribute.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Drive to Safeway each week and go through each department to pick up donated goods
- Weigh food and deliver to DAWN's shelter
- Assist shelter staff with organizing food into freezers/refrigerators
- Build and maintain relationships with Safeway department managers

Time Commitment:

Must commit to at least 2 shifts per month. Shifts take place on Friday mornings between 9-12 pm.

Requirements:

- Complete a volunteer application and interview
- Must have valid driver's license and proof of insurance
- Volunteer can drive own vehicle or use one provided by DAWN
- Background check
- Must complete training once accepted

Qualifications/Skills:

- Ability to lift up to 50 pounds
- Committed and reliable
- Friendly/outgoing personality
