Job Responsibilities

Main Duties

- Provide brief assessments to referred program participants with mental health concerns
- Provide brief screenings to referred program participants with chemical dependency concerns
- Provide trauma informed mental health treatment to a designated number of program participants
- Provide crisis intervention services to program participants
- Ensure program participants are linked with appropriate mental health/chemical dependency services
- Maintain all records/documentation as required by agency policy and reporting requirements
- Attend and participate in all supervision/collaborative meetings and trainings
- Ensure the accurate and timely submission of required reports/forms/statistics
- Facilitate support group(s)
- Supervision of Master Level Social Work/Counseling Interns
- Collaborate with agency leadership in program development
